- Official selection date: 02.07.2025 (tbc)
- Official media release: probably 4.07.2025 (tbc)
- Sport entry deadline: 7.7.2025 (tbc)

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, athletes must:

- Be born in 2008, 2009, or 2010.
- Holder of the Swiss nationality.
- Must be part of the Swiss National Team.
- Holder of the Kukkiwon Poom Certificate
- Meet the international minimum standards specified in the selection criteria

Medal points after one win count for Coef 1 only. The athlete must win at least two matches to get the medal points for Coef 2 and higher. Byes count as wins only if the seeded athlete wins their first match

Points Allocation

Coefficient 1: 1st place (5 pts); 2nd place (3 pts); 3rd place (1 pt)

Coefficient 2: 1st place (10 pts); 2nd place (6 pts); 3rd place (3 pts); 1 match won (1 add. pt. per match won)

Coefficient 3: 1st place (20 pts); 2nd place (12 pts); 3rd place (6 pts); 1 match won (2 add. pt. per match won)

Coefficient 4: 1st place (30 pts); 2nd place (18 pts); 3rd place (10 pts); 1 match won (3 add. pt. per match won)

Obligations and Code of Conduct

- 1. Training Camp: Selected athletes are required to participate in the preparatory training camp.
- 2. Ethics Commitment: In order for an athlete to be proposed for selection, they must acknowledge and adhere to the ethical principles of sport.
